Dear Parents

Due to its success in previous year, we will be continuing the weekly homework club on a Wednesday from 3:25 until 4:15pm from 14th September 2016. The club will provide a quiet, supported and well-resourced environment for the children to complete homework.

The club will be staffed by teachers and LSA's to support the children with their homework. For those children who wish to attend the homework club, there is a Code of Conduct attached for you to read through and discuss with your child. This is to ensure that everyone who attends the club has the opportunity to complete their homework in a calm and productive environment. Children who do not adhere to the Code will be asked not to attend the club.

Children who would like to come along to homework club can do so on a flexible basis. They will not be expected to attend every week if they do not need to or want to. However, once they have signed in at the start of the session, they will not be permitted to leave until 4:15. If they have finished their homework task, there will be activities for them to do until it is time to leave.

It is still an expectation that your child will read regularly at home and that spellings will be learnt as usual.

Homework Club - Code of Conduct

Homework Club will be an opportunity for you to complete your home learning in a quiet place, where you will be able to use school equipment including the ICT suite and the library. There will also be adults at the club to help you understand your homework.

For everyone to be able to get their homework done properly, we need to have some ground rules. We expect your behaviour to be of the same standard as we see during the school day.

Do...

- ★ Sign in at the start of the session so that we know who is in the building.
- ★ Bring your homework instructions with you because the teacher who is working with you may not have set it.
- ★ Come to the club with a good attitude. Sometimes you may find the homework tricky, but be prepared to keep trying until you can do it. We will be there to help you!
- ★ Make sure your parents know that you are coming to Homework club and arrange where you will be meeting them after the club has finished. If the person who is picking you up is not there, come back into the school office.
- ★ Enjoy playing some games and activities once you have completed your homework.
- ★ Continue to read your home reading book regularly at home.
- ★ Learn your spellings at home ready for your spelling test.
- ★ Use the homework club to work on the current Home/School Project –more information to follow!

Do not...

- ★ Leave the building until the adult has said you can at 4:15.
- ★ Stop other children learning or completing their homework by behaving in a way that is disruptive or distracting.

We are quite sure that it won't need to happen, but if we feel that you are not able to follow this code of conduct, we will ask you to no longer come to homework club. This is so that other children can complete their home learning in a calm and quiet place.
